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**Minister's Note**

**10 April 2016**

Today we start a new series, "*Adventures in Resurrection*", focussing on some key moments in the book of Acts.

For me, the word "adventure" evokes three things. Firstly, I think of adventure as a journey to a new place. In Acts Christians were known as people of "*The Way*". They followed the Holy Spirit in the journey of creating a new community of loving persons with God at their centre. Adventure also conjures up the excitement of unexpected discovery. The people of The Way discovered the beauty of life in community, the power of prayer and the unexpected reality that even Gentiles were to be included in their new community. Adventure takes us to high points of "discovery" but it also passes through dark valleys. In Acts every new thing God does faces vigorous opposition from the forces of darkness. Stephen was stoned to death, James was killed with the sword and men and women were rounded up and imprisoned.

You and I are called to follow the Resurrected Jesus on The Way. We'll discover new things and we will encounter opposition. But in the highs and lows, this truth remains: Jesus is the Son of God who has opened the Kingdom of God to all.
