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Minister's Note

3 April 2016

Today, in our morning services, we welcome Rev. John McKaig. John, as many of you know, was DMC's first minister! (Londiwe has a trial service at Parkwood Methodist and I am taking my quarterly weekend off.)

Today's Gospel (John 20:19-31) recounts how the disciples met, fearfully behind locked doors, on the evening of the first day of the week. But *"Jesus came and stood among them and said, 'Peace be with you!' (:19).*

When it was time to bid farewell Jesus again greeted them with the customary *"Shalom"* or *"Peace be with you"*. However, he followed his greeting with a command *"As the Father has sent me, so I am sending you"*. The picture we have in our minds is that Jesus then left them. However, we should probably think of it like this: it is the disciples who leave (they are sent) with a message to share. And that is how it has been every Sunday since. We, the followers of Jesus meet; we are renewed, and sent back into an often dark and scary world as people of healing, hope and love. We are what Trevor Hudson calls, *"Easter people living in a Good Friday World"*.
