Welcome

Worship

Sing a song of praise.

Word

- What do you discover about the Holy Spirit in this passage? (Reading Acts 2: 42-66 will help you in understanding more about the role of the Holy Spirit.)
- What does the passage teach you about the human condition? (What are our weaknesses? What are our needs?)

Works

- In Romans 8:6 Paul declares: "The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace"
- Confess to any areas of your lives not fully governed by the Spirit. (Any activity that does not lead to a life of peace).
- How can you submit to being "led by the Spirit of God"?
