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Minister's Note

19 June 2016

You and I share our humanity with every other person on the planet. Yet, sadly, we haven't yet learned how to live together as a human family. This is painfully apparent as we look back at our violent past (e.g. June 16th) and also in more recent horrors (e.g. Orlando massacre).

Human beings have shed one another's blood. But, through the blood of Christ, God is putting things right. Miroslav Volf puts it this way:

*"You were slaughtered and by your blood you ransomed for God saints from every tribe and language and people and nation (Rev. 5:9)". **There is no longer Jew or Greek, there is no longer slave or free, there is no longer male nor female, for all of you are one in Christ Jesus (Gal. 3:28)**'.*

*"All the churches of Jesus Christ, scattered in diverse cultures, have been redeemed for God by the blood of the Lamb to form one multicultural community of faith. The 'blood' that binds them as brothers and sisters is more precious than the 'blood,' the language, the customs, political allegiances, or economic interests that may separate them."*¹

In a time of confusion, chaos and hatred may Christians everywhere show the world the way of peace and harmony.
