MINISTER'S NOTE

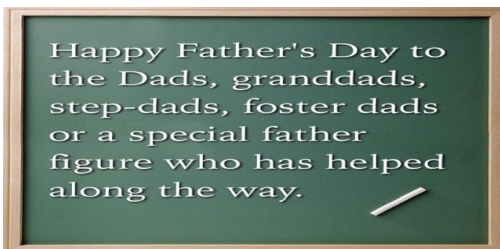
